Sandusky High School Class of 1965 – Summary Report 50th Reunion



The budget for our 50th Reunion was based on three categories of spending. The spending details of each category can be found at the end of this report (pg.9).

Fixed Operating included a variety of needs our class has in between reunion years with communication, website, banking, and preliminary event printing/mailing. These costs are fairly consistent and need to be projected for the next five years. Thanks to the generosity of classmates, all fixed operating expenses were paid for through their donations, and not passed along as part of the per person reunion cost. "Paid" column represents cash payments and the "Donated" column represents an estimated value for items & services donated by classmates. This resulted in a savings for both the classmate and their guest.

Fixed Events are specific to facility fees, entertainment, nametags, signage, decorations, giveaways, etc. that are unique to each event offered. They are referred to as "fixed" events because their costs are relatively predictable for purposes of budgeting. This category did go over budget, though, as more reservations were made, more centerpieces, nametags, etc. were needed. But, thanks to the generosity of classmates, all fixed operating expenses were paid for through their donations (both cash and donated goods & services), and not passed along as part of the per person reunion cost. This resulted in a savings for both the classmate and their guest. Because of these extra funds, our 50th reunion was able to offer first class venues and entertainment for a three day weekend celebration.

The <u>Variable Events/Food</u> category is so named because it was completely dependent on the number of persons attending any one event. It was also influenced by the different classmate discounts offered at each of three events. When budgeting for the reunion it was very important to assure we had sufficient money in reserve to cover all classmates attending as their discount was part of the actual amount due to each vendor. *Thanks for the continued generosity of our classmates we were able to offer a 20% food discount for Friday, 26% for Saturday and 25% for Sunday events.*

The Fixed Operating, Fixed Event and Variable Events combine for a total Reunion Expense of \$20,506.05.

(\$18,081.05 paid in cash an estimated \$2,425 in donated goods & services).



Budgeting for this Reunion differed from past class events because of various fundraisers and money making events between 2010-2015. Past reunions have typically had \$6,000 - \$7,000 passing through the Treasury. This time, since the last reunion, more than \$20,000 has passed through the Treasury. The reason stems from the difference of having all expenses for this reunion passed directly on to classmates through their reservation fee as had been the norm. This time, in preparation for a "special" 50th Reunion, new sources of revenue were created through various fundraisers. This created opportunities for an expanded reunion venues, events and classmate discounts for meals. It also created a need to establish a budget and closely monitor income and expenses

The start figure for reunion planning began with the total of money in our Class Treasury as of January 1, 2014 (see above). Funds that had previously been raised for the 50th Reunion were separated from the total and used as part of the Reunion Budget. The remaining \$627.45 was put on "hold" and held in reserve as a backup security in case of budget overruns. This money was never needed for the Reunion and will carry forward in our Treasury.

Continuing to use a start date of January 1, 2014 we had a Treasury balance of \$2,057.21 before the Reunion. Additional deposits made in 2014-2015 included donations from our pre-union fundraiser, reservations, and donations for our post-reunion fundraiser. After all expenses paid, our Treasury has a balance of \$3,253.54. The distribution of those funds falls into three groups: the Treasury Reserve (never budgeted for class expenses), Donations for post-reunion expenses including but not limited to funding the class website and future class events (i.e. 70th birthday party and 55th Reunion), and Budget Surplus coming from the planning for the 50th reunion. While the surplus for the Fixed costs came close to projections, the surplus for the Variable Events was larger than anticipated. This was a result of projections made for classmate food discounts that were "variable" until reservations came in and final counts on food were taken by the vendors. The Planning Committee made budget projections higher than expected to safe guard that funds would be available for classmate food discounts plus our vendors were generous with their head counts.

To better understand the "surplus" created in "Variable Events/Food", the following is a breakdown on variable food expenses for each event.

More persons attended this event than projected although the overall expenses remained less than anticipated. Reservations funds paid by classmates exceeded the actual costs of food. With a food budget of \$1,760 (including allocated classmate discounts) we ended with a surplus of \$746.13. Although we did not spend the full budgeted amount, we had more than enough food. The extras were donated to Stein Hospice and Care/Share.

More persons attended this event than projected, although the classmate discount of \$13 was projected high to assure there would be sufficient funds in the event of high attendance, and as it turned out, a good decision for this funding. When the actual food expenses were combined with the discount funds reserved (\$1,352) we ended with a surplus of \$100. This event also benefited from a low count from our vendor.

Actual attendance at this event was more than twice expected. Still, the food expenses paid by classmates when added to classmate discount funds and money reserved for teacher meals totaled \$3,054.18 still giving us a budget <u>surplus of \$277.43</u>. This event benefited greatly from two things. First, the buffet price of \$14.95 negotiated over a year ago was honored, even though the brunch offered normally is priced for a large group at \$20 per person. Secondly, we benefited from a low count from our vendor, part in due to some persons attending the brunch who did not eat (speakers, entertainers, etc.)
